## **Committee Reports:**

- --Membership-Bud read names of members we need to contact.
- --Color Guard slacks-Bud got to Jack's Uniforms. Jacks' does not and cannot get our slacks. Bud ordered a pair from Haband to see if they are like the ones we have. Should have in 6-8 days. Otherwise we may have to go to Stadium Sports.
- --District 3 fundraiser report by Bud: Cedar County Posts hosted at Laurel. Soups and sandwiches, split the pot, bake sale; and silent auction. Host Post gets \$100.00 and everyone helps set up and clean up and serve. Had a very successful day and met some very nice people. We all had a great time even with the power outage. Total in donations was \$2790.00. After expenses, it will be split between the District Legion, Auxiliary and Norfolk Veteran's Home.
- --Storage-Cmdr. Janssen talked with Village of Winside. They will not allow conex or semi-trailers in town. Cmdr. Janssen did find a 12 X 24 wooden building at Burt Motors in Norfolk, with a wooden floor, window, walk-in door and overhead door. The price is \$4600.00 with a 5 yr. warranty. City would approve this type of building. The building would be delivered and set by the Amish. Discussion of different of building was a pole building. Need to check prices at Menards, Lowe's, and Farm & Ranch. Talk to NECC Construction class to see if they would construct. Sizes to price are: 18 X 32 X 12; 24 X 32 X 12; 30 X 32 X 12 with one 36" walk-in door and 10' overhead door.

- --Cmdr. Janssen reported he has checked into WiFi for Post Home. It is \$49.95 a month, which is too high. There may be a change coming to NNTC, upgrading. It was suggested we hold off. Might raise the rent in January approximately \$15.00 a rental. Building is rented 25-30 times a year. If we raise it \$10.00 per rental, that would be \$250-300.00. If we raise rent \$15.00 per rental, that would be \$375-\$450.00 a year. Wifi will cost a minimum of \$600.00 a year plus taxes. Dave Bloomfield moved to raise the rent \$10.00 to \$85.00 per rental as of 1-1-17, Gerald Kennedy seconded, motion passed.
- --Dave Bloomfield still has the 65" Mitsibushi flat screen TV that needs about \$300.00 of work. Mid-City in Norfolk could do the work on the TV. Question: Is it computer compatible? Dave is not sure. It was mentioned we can buy new 43" LED TV's for less than \$300.00, computer compatible. Table TV until we know more about it.
- --Cmdr. Janssen reported on Liquor license. The cost is \$750.00 a year. We do not have enough people and supplies to make this work and be held responsible for alcohol inside the building. Would need bartenders and security for rentals to protect the license.
- --Snow removal-Kyle Skokan has been approached, need a price from him.
- --Operation Comfort Warrior donation from Bev Ruwe. Bud reported about the program. Every dollar that is donated, goes to help a Warrior in need.
- --OMELET FEED—will be Sunday, December 18, 9 AM to 1 PM. Ron Sebade donated a hog for the Omelet Feed. Bud will send him a Thank You and an invite to attend the omelet feed for two free meals.
- --Sunday, November 20 at 2 PM, the Winside SAL #252 will have their Root Beer Floats at the Norfolk Veteran's home.
- --Friday, November 11 at 8:30 AM is the Veteran's Day program at the Winside School. Daryl Mundil and Marcus Janssen will be the Color Guard. Mrs. Quinn has guest speaker lined up.
